WHEREAS: Addressing these complex medical needs early in life is imperative to helping

families successfully care for their children at home. There is a desperate need for

more education, awareness, and support for families; and

WHEREAS: In an effort to bring awareness, Lissencephaly Foundation Inc. helps support

individuals through their continued efforts of empowering families and

educating communities; and
