that occurred on March 18, 1937, leading to the widespread odorization of

natural gas and an increased emphasis on safety; and

WHEREAS: Safety is a vital aspect of natural gas distribution and the employees of

distribution companies' endeavor to make natural gas delivery as safe as

possible; and

WHEREAS: It is the attention and dedication of our utility workers that ensures the safety of

natural gas distribution; and

WHEREAS: On Natural Gas Utility Workers' Day and throughout the year, we recognize the

vital services these workers provide to their communities and the State of

Georgia; now

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim THEREFORE:
