State of Georgia, and reduce legal costs to the public; and

WHEREAS: Excellence, dedication, and integrity are the noteworthy characteristics of

paralegals and those in Georgia uphold the highest standards of professionalism;

and

WHEREAS: The observance of Paralegal Week provides an opportunity for Georgians to

recognize paralegals throughout the state for their efforts to help our legal

system perform at a high level of efficiency; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

June 6-12, 2021, as PARALEGAL WEEK in Georgia.
