POLLINATOR WEEK

WHEREAS: Pollinator species such as birds and insects are important partners to the farmers and

ranchers that produce the majority of our food supply; and

WHEREAS: Pollination is vital to the health of Georgia's national forests and grasslands which provide

recreational opportunities, enhanced economic development opportunities for communities, and an abundance of natural resources. These resources include timber, fish

and wildlife, water, and mineral resources; and

WHEREAS: Pollinator species provide significant environmental benefits that are necessary for

maintaining healthy, biodiverse ecosystems; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia has managed wildlife habitats and public lands such as Georgia forests

and grasslands for decades; and

WHEREAS: Georgia provides producers with conservation assistance to promote prudent conservation

stewardship, including the protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on

all lands; and

WHEREAS: Georgians are encouraged to learn more about the critical economic and environmental

contributions of pollinators; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 21st

through 27th 2021 as POLLINATOR WEEK in Georgia.
