APROCLAMATION

SHOOTING SPORTS MONTH

WHEREAS: Hunting, firearms, and the shooting sports are part of the history, tradition, and

culture of the Great State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Increasing access to education and shooting sports provides opportunity to

safely learn to shoot and to responsibly increase public participation in shooting

sports and hunting; and

WHEREAS: Millions of Georgians, young and old, participate in hunting and shooting sports

every year; and

WHEREAS: Sportsmen and hunters teach others to understand the responsibilities of

owning and using a firearm, while also working to ensure natural resources are

safeguarded; and

WHEREAS: The firearm and ammunition industry contributed as much as \$2.13 billion to

the Georgia economy in 2020 and supported 10,763 jobs; and

WHEREAS: Georgia received more than \$21.1 million in funding for wildlife and

conservation efforts through the Pittman-Robertson excise tax levied on

firearms and ammunition in 2020; and

WHEREAS: Spotlighting shooting sports activities enjoyed by millions of Americans will

continue to promote a culture of safety and responsibility; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

August 2021 as SHOOTING SPORTS MONTH in Georgia.
