A PROCLAMATION SUPPORTING LIBERTY FOR THE CUBAN PEOPLE

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia and Governor Brian P. Kemp unequivocally support the people of Cuba in their fight for liberty from their communist government; and

WHEREAS: Cubans have experienced over 60 years of oppression under authoritarian rule. Most recently, an economy crippled by shortages and lack of growth has afflicted the citizens of Cuba; and

WHEREAS: In response to the unacceptable conditions forced on them by the communist regime, brave Cubans have taken to the streets in unprecedented protests for freedom despite heightened government oppression and brutality; and

WHEREAS: We must recognize the right of Cubans to be free from a communist government that does not protect their basic human rights or guarantee economic opportunity for all. The State of Georgia is proud to support the people of Cuba in their stand against their communist oppressors to achieve freedom and prosperity; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim SUPPORTING LIBERTY FOR THE CUBAN PEOPLE.
