Because the Vidalia Onion Festival operates on local contributions, event sponsorships, and limited revenue-generating activities, all funds are donated directly to the community throughout the year; and

This year's festival includes local contests, talent shows, and creative activities that will allow countless Americans to join in the celebration of the 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Vidalia Onion Festival; and

WHEREAS:

The Vidalia Onion Festival Days will give community members multiple opportunities to celebrate the harvest. Through parades, concerts, and fireworks, the festival will showcase the heart of Vidalia and the importance of the Vidalia onion; now
