## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 3 of Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia
Annotated, relating to pay, pensions, and allowances of state military personnel, so as to
authorize pay for certain active duty by the organized militia; to provide for related matters;
to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** Part 3 of Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 7 8 relating to pay, pensions, and allowances of state military personnel, is amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 38-2-250, relating to pay while on active service, special duty. 9 10 travel expenses, and minimum base pay, as follows: 11 "(a) Each member of the militia ordered into the active service of the state pursuant to 12 Code Sections 38-2-6, 38-2-6.1, and 38-2-72 or Code Section 45-12-31 or 45-12-34, shall 13 receive for each day of such duty the same pay and allowances received by members of the 14 appropriate force of the armed forces of the United States of corresponding grade, rating, and length of service." 15

## **SECTION 2.**
