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House Bill 346 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to emergency medical services personnel, so as to authorize the administration of
- 3 hydrocortisone sodium succinate by paramedics to patients with congenital adrenal
- 4 hyperplasia under certain conditions; to provide for definitions; to provide for requirements;
- 5 to provide for immunity; to provide for related matters; to provide for a short title; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 This Act shall be known and may be cited as "Jarom's Act."
- 10 SECTION 2.
- 11 Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 12 emergency medical services personnel, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 "<u>31-11-55.2.</u>
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:

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16 (1) 'Congenital adrenal hyperplasia' means the salt wasting form of the classic type of

- 17 <u>congenital adrenal hyperplasia.</u>
- 18 (2) 'Emergency medical services personnel' means any person who has been certified as
- 19 <u>an emergency medical technician, cardiac technician, or paramedic.</u>
- 20 (b) Paramedics shall be authorized to administer hydrocortisone sodium succinate
- 21 <u>intramuscularly for the purpose of providing emergency care to a patient who:</u>
- 22 (1) Has congenital adrenal hyperplasia; or any adrenal insufficiency;
- 23 (2) Is believed to be in adrenal crisis; and
- 24 (3) Has on his or her person or in his or her belongings hydrocortisone sodium succinate
- in packaging that clearly states the appropriate dosage and has an unbroken seal.
- 26 (c) In order to ensure public health and safety:
- 27 (1) All emergency medical services personnel shall obtain appropriate training on
- congenital adrenal hyperplasia, and all paramedics shall obtain appropriate training
- 29 regarding administration of hydrocortisone sodium succinate as set forth in the rules and
- regulations of the Department of Public Health; and
- 31 (2) Within a reasonable period of time, all paramedics who administer hydrocortisone
- 32 sodium succinate shall make available a printed or electronically stored report to the
- 33 <u>licensed ambulance service which transports the patient.</u>
- 34 (d) The immunity provided in Code Section 31-11-8 shall apply to any paramedic who in
- 35 good faith renders emergency care pursuant to this Code section."

36 SECTION 3.

37 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
