A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Stewart County, approved
2 April 4, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 4028), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
3 April 4, 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 3845), so as to revise provisions relating to purchases and
4 bids; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Stewart County, approved April 4, 1996
8 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 4028), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 4, 1997
9 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 3845), is amended by revising Section 12 as follows:

10 style="text-align:center">SECTION 12.

11 Any bid or proposal for goods, services, or both, valued at \$40,000.00 or more shall be
12 advertised for two weeks in the official organ of the county and in the Georgia Procurement
13 Registry established by the Georgia Department of Administrative Services and managed by
14 the agency's State Purchasing Division. The need for advertising may be dispensed with by
15 the board of commissioners if it determines that an emergency exists that will not permit a

16 delay. Formal sealed bids shall also be required for purchases that exceed the sum
17 of \$100,000.00.

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
