A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing that the governing authority of each county comprising the  
2 Waycross Judicial Circuit may supplement the compensation, salary, expenses, and  
3 allowances of each of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit,  
4 approved March 20, 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 3879), as amended, particularly by an Act  
5 approved May 8, 2018 (Ga. L. 2018, p. 3975), so as to increase the amounts of such  
6 supplements; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting  
7 laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act providing that the governing authority of each county comprising the Waycross  
11 Judicial Circuit may supplement the compensation, salary, expenses, and allowances of each  
12 of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit, approved  
13 March 20, 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 3879), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
14 May 8, 2018 (Ga. L. 2018, p. 3975), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

15 **"Section 1.** In addition to the compensation, salary, expenses, and allowances presently  
16 being received by the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit from

17 the State of Georgia or from any other source, the governing authority of each county  
18 comprising the Waycross Judicial Circuit shall supplement the compensation, salary,  
19 expenses, and allowances of each of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross  
20 Judicial Circuit. The division of payment among the six counties shall not be less than the  
21 following amounts for each judge:

22	Bacon	\$490.00 per month
23	Brantley	\$590.00 per month
24	Charlton	\$490.00 per month
25	Coffee	\$1,000.00 per month
26	Pierce	\$590.00 per month
27	Ware	\$1,000.00 per month"

28 **SECTION 2.**

29 This Act shall become effective upon approval by the Governor or upon becoming law  
30 without such approval.

31 **SECTION 3.**

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
