A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Blue Ridge in Fannin County,
- 2 approved March 21, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 3823), as amended, so as to provide for staggered
- 3 terms of the mayor and councilmembers; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Blue Ridge in Fannin County, approved
- 8 March 21, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 3823), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (b)
- 9 of Section 2.10 as follows:
- 10 "(b) The mayor and councilmembers shall serve for staggered terms of four years and until
- their respective successors are elected and qualified. No person shall be eligible to serve
- as mayor or councilmember unless he or she shall have been a resident of this city for 12
- months immediately preceding the election of mayor or councilmember. Each such person
- shall continue to reside within the city during said period of service and shall be registered
- and qualified to vote in municipal elections of the city. No person's name shall be listed
- as a candidate on the ballot for election for either mayor or councilmember unless such

person shall file a written notice with the clerk of said city that he or she desires his or her

- 18 name to be placed on said ballot as a candidate either for mayor or councilmember. No
- 19 person shall be eligible for the office of mayor or councilmember unless such person shall
- 20 file such notice within the time provided by Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A, the

21 'Georgia Election Code.'"

SECTION 2.

- 23 Said Act is further amended by revising subsection (e) of Section 2.11 as follows:
- 24 "(e)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the mayor and
- councilmembers shall serve terms of four years. Municipal general elections for the city
- shall be held on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November of odd-numbered years.
- 27 The terms of office for mayor and councilmembers shall begin at the time such individual
- takes the oath of office provided for in Section 3.11 of this charter.
- 29 (2) The mayor and councilmembers for Posts 2 and 4 elected at the municipal general
- election of 2021 shall serve a term of four years. The councilmembers for Posts 1, 3,
- and 5 elected at the municipal general election of 2021 shall serve a term of two years.
- 32 (3) Nothing herein shall affect the term of office of the mayor and councilmembers
- serving on the effective date of this Act."

34 SECTION 3.

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
