A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Ms. Sydnie Grace Jones and dedicating an intersection in
2 her memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its most promising young citizens with the
4 tragic passing of Ms. Sydnie Grace Jones; and

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Jones was born on May 3, 2001, in Blue Ridge, Georgia, the beloved
6 daughter of Anthony Jones and Melinda Joy Rogers Jones; and

7 WHEREAS, a graduate of Fannin County High School, Ms. Jones was a member of the
8 school's soccer and volleyball teams and enjoyed skateboarding; and

9 WHEREAS, she loved spending time with friends and watching rooftop sunsets from her
10 family home; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Jones attended The Ridge Community Church and was an active member
12 of the First Baptist Church of Blue Ridge youth group; and

13 WHEREAS, she had an eye for fashion and enjoyed shopping at thrift clothing stores and
14 putting together unique and stylish outfits with her finds; and

15 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous young woman, Ms. Jones will long be
16 remembered for her love of family and friendship, and this loyal daughter, granddaughter,
17 and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
19 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in her memory.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 515 and State Route 325 in
22 Union County is dedicated as the Sydnie Grace Jones Memorial Intersection.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
24 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Sydnie Grace Jones Memorial
25 Intersection.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
27 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
28 family of Ms. Sydnie Grace Jones and to the Department of Transportation.
