A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 7 of Chapter 2 of Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to meetings, so as to provide that a corporation may hold annual
- 3 shareholders' meetings and special shareholders' meetings by means of remote
- 4 communication; to provide for requirements for such meetings by remote communication;
- 5 to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 6 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 1 of Article 7 of Chapter 2 of Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to meetings, is amended by revising subsection (b) of Code Section 14-2-701,
- 11 relating to annual meeting, as follows:
- 12 "(b)(1) Except as provided for in paragraph (2) of this subsection, annual Annual
- shareholders' meetings may be held in or out of this state at the place stated in or fixed
- in accordance with the bylaws. If no place is stated in or fixed in accordance with the
- bylaws, annual <u>shareholders'</u> meetings shall be held at the corporation's principal office.

16 (2) Unless the articles of incorporation or the bylaws provide otherwise, the board of

- directors may determine that an annual shareholders' meeting be held wholly or partially
- by means of remote communication as authorized by Code Section 14-2-708."

19 SECTION 2.

- 20 Said part is further amended by revising subsection (c) of Code Section 14-2-702, relating
- 21 to special meeting, as follows:
- 22 "(c)(1) Except as provided for under paragraph (2) of this subsection, special Special
- shareholders' meetings may be held in or out of this state at the place stated in or fixed
- in accordance with the bylaws. If no place is stated or fixed in accordance with the
- bylaws, special shareholders' meetings shall be held at the corporation's principal office.
- 26 (2) Unless the articles of incorporation or the bylaws provide otherwise, the board of
- 27 <u>directors may determine that a special shareholders' meeting be held wholly or partially</u>
- by means of remote communication as authorized by Code Section 14-2-708."
- SECTION 3.
- 30 Said part is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 31 "14-2-708.
- When authorized by the board of directors, and subject to such guidelines and procedures
- as the board of directors may adopt, shareholders and holders of proxies of any class or
- 34 series designated by the board of directors not physically present at a meeting of
- 35 shareholders may, by means of remote communication:
- 36 (1) Participate in a meeting of shareholders; and
- 37 (2) Be deemed present in person and vote at a meeting of shareholders, whether such
- meeting is held at a designated place or held solely by means of remote communication,
- 39 provided that:

40	(A) The corporation implements reasonable procedures to verify that each person
41	deemed present and permitted to vote at the meeting by means of remote
42	communication is a shareholder or holder of a proxy;
43	(B) The corporation implements reasonable procedures to provide such shareholders
44	and holders of proxies a reasonable opportunity to participate in the meeting and to vote
45	on matters submitted to such shareholders and holders of proxies, including, but not
46	limited to, an opportunity to read or hear the proceedings of the meeting substantially
47	concurrently with such proceedings; and
48	(C) When any shareholder or holder of a proxy votes or takes other action at the
49	meeting by means of remote communication, a record of such vote or other action shall
50	be maintained by the corporation."

51 SECTION 4.

- 52 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law 53 without such approval.
- 54 SECTION 5.
- 55 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
