EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

On August 2, 2021, Mr. Royce Reeves, Ward 2 Commissioner on the Cordele City WHEREAS:

> Commission, was indicted on two counts of Obstruction of an Officer, one count of Violation of Oath by a Public Officer, one count of Criminal Trespass, and one

The indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(b), WHEREAS:

and the certified copy was received on August 11, 2021; and

An Executive Order was issued on September 7, 2021, appointing members to the WHEREAS:

> Review Commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the office of City Commissioner such that the rights

and interests of the public are adversely affected; and

WHEREAS: The Review Commission found that the indictment of Mr. Royce Reeves does relate

> to and does adversely affect the administration of duties by Commissioner Reeves, and that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby; and recommended that Mr. Reeves be suspended from office pursuant to the

provisions of O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

That Mr. Royce Reeves is hereby suspended from office immediately and without ORDERED: further action pending the final disposition of the case or until the expiration of his

term of office, whichever occurs first, as provided in 45-5-6(c).
