## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: The Honorable Madeleine Korbel Albright passed away on March 23,

2022; and

WHEREAS: Mrs. Albright served as the 64<sup>th</sup> U.S. Secretary of State from 1997 to

2001. She was the first female Secretary of State in U.S. history; and

WHEREAS: In addition to her service as Secretary of State, she also served on the

National Security Council under President Jimmy Carter, and as an

Ambassador to the United Nations; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Secretary Albright's service to

citizens of the United States of America by lowering the flags

throughout Georgia to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of The Honorable Madeleine Korbel Albright, pursuant to the authority vested in me as

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**Ordered:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia

shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds from this

date until sunset on Sunday, March 27, 2022.
