EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 1.285 acres of real property

("Property") as shown as Tract "D" on the survey attached hereto as Exhibit "A",

which Property is a portion of the Southwestern State Hospital; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is a portion of the 207.852 acres of real property located at 430 S.

Pinetree Blvd, in Land Lots 5, 6, 41, and 42, 13th Land District, Thomas County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of Quitclaim Deeds dated June 14, 1966, and August 8, 1973, recorded in Deed Book 27, Pages 625-645, and Deed Book 75, Pages 599-611, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Thomas County, and filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Records as RPR # 03432, RPR #

004927, and RPR # 003432.01 respectively; and

WHEREAS: By Resolution dated August 18, 2016, the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health

and Developmental Disabilities declared the Property surplus to the needs of the

Department; and

WHEREAS: By Resolution dated March 17, 2021, the Georgia Department of Community

Supervision requested custody of the Property for the purposes of operating a

Community Supervision Field Office and a Day Reporting Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That custody of the above-defined Property located in Thomas County, Georgia is

hereby transferred from the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and

Developmental Disabilities to the Georgia Department of Community Supervision.
