EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN SPALDING COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

- WHEREAS:** Deputy Jamie Reynolds with the Spalding County Sheriff's Office, was killed in the line of duty on Sunday, July 31, 2022, when a tree fell and crushed the passenger side of his vehicle; and
- WHEREAS:** Deputy Reynolds began his career in law enforcement in 1995 and joined the Spalding County Sheriff's Office in 2021; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Deputy Reynolds' service to Spalding County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Spalding County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF DEPUTY JAMIE REYNOLDS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Spalding County on Saturday, August 6, 2022, the day of Deputy Reynolds' interment, until sunset.
