EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN COBB COUNTY
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Deputy Marshall Samuel Ervin, Jr., 38, with the Cobb County Sheriff's Office, was killed in the line of duty on Thursday, September 8, 2022, while attempting to serve a warrant; and

WHEREAS: Deputy Ervin honorably served with the Cobb County Sheriff's Office for seven years; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Deputy Marshall Samuel Ervin, Jr.'s service to Cobb County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Cobb County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF DEPUTY MARSHALL SAMUEL ERVIN, JR., PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Cobb County on Thursday, September 15, 2022, the day of Deputy Ervin's interment, until sunset.
