EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN COOK COUNTY
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Captain Terry “Turtle” Randall Arnold, 59, with the Cook County Sheriff’s Office, passed away on October 3, 2022, after responding to a fight between two students; and

WHEREAS: Captain Arnold served with the Cook County Sheriff’s Office for 28 years and previously served with the Remerton Police Department for two years and the Adel Police Department for five years; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Captain Arnold’s service to Cook County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Cook County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF CAPTAIN TERRY RANDALL ARNOLD, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Cook County on Monday, October 10, 2022, the day of Captain Arnold’s interment, until sunset.
