### **FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

**WHEREAS:** The state of Georgia mourns the loss of State Representative Henry “Wayne” Howard who passed away on October 13, 2022; and

**WHEREAS:** Representative Howard served the citizens of Georgia’s 124<sup>th</sup> District (formerly 121<sup>st</sup> District) in the Georgia House of Representatives from 2007 – 2022; and

**WHEREAS:** Wayne Howard was a successful businessman, and a public servant who developed a reputation of service, reliability, and loyalty.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF REPRESENTATIVE HENRY “WAYNE” HOWARD, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the state of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds throughout Georgia on Thursday, October 20, 2022, the day of Representative Howard’s interment.
