## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, IN ATHENS-CLARKE COUNTY & AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Mr. Charles Louis "Charley" Trippi, 100, a legendary former University of

Georgia football player, passed away on October 19, 2022; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Trippi is admired as one of the greatest football players in the University

of Georgia's storied history; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Trippi earned a scholarship and played football for the University of

Georgia from 1942 to 1946 and helped take his Bulldogs to the Rose Bowl,

winning the 1942 National Championship; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Trippi took leave from his collegiate career to serve in the United States

Army Air Corps during World War II where he played for the Third Air

Force Gremlins football team; and

WHEREAS: In 1947, the University of Georgia retired Mr. Trippi's jersey number, #62,

one of only four UGA football players to receive this honor; and

**WHEREAS:** Mr. Trippi played football professionally with the National Football League

and was inducted into the national College Football Hall of Fame, the national Pro Football Hall of Fame, the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame, and the

Georgia Sports Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Charley Trippi's life by lowering the flags

on the State Capitol Building, in Athens-Clarke County, and on all buildings

and campuses of the University of Georgia to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Mr. Charles Louis "Charley" Trippi, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol Building, in Athens-Clarke County, and on all buildings and campuses of the University of Georgia on November 5, 2022.
