EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN GWINNETT COUNTY
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Gwinnett County Senior Corrections Officer Scott Ozburn Riner passed away on December 13, 2022, after being shot in the parking lot of the Gwinnett County Comprehensive Correctional Complex as he prepared to begin his shift; and

WHEREAS: Officer Riner served Gwinnett County as a correctional officer since June 2010; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Riner's service to Gwinnett County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Gwinnett County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF OFFICER SCOTT OZBURN RINER, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Gwinnett County on Tuesday, December 20, 2022, the day of Officer Riner's interment, until sunset.
