## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

### **FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED TO HALF STAFF**

**WHEREAS:** The Honorable Clyde L. Reese, Judge of the Court of Appeals of the State of Georgia, passed away on Saturday, December 17, 2022; and

**WHEREAS:** Judge Reese honorably served the citizens of Georgia first as an Assistant Attorney General in the Georgia Department of Law, and later as counsel for the Georgia Department of Insurance, the Subsequent Injury Trust Fund, and the State Health Planning Agency; and

**WHEREAS:** Judge Reese also served as Commissioner of the Department of Community Health and the Department of Human Services before his 2016 appointment to the Court of Appeals of the State of Georgia; and

**WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Judge Reese's service to citizens of the State of Georgia by lowering the flags throughout Georgia to half-staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE CLYDE L. REESE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on all State buildings and grounds on Monday, December 19, 2022, and until sunset on the day of Judge Reese's interment.
