APPRENTICESHIP WEEK

WHEREAS:

Apprenticeships provide accessible pathways for Georgians to obtain quality,

in-demand jobs in well-paying careers; and

WHEREAS:

Apprenticeships enable Georgia businesses to develop and train their future workforce to build local, industry-leading talent as well as advance and grow Georgia's economy, lifting households and communities into greater prosperity

through quality jobs; and

WHEREAS:

The State of Georgia has made historic state investments into the expansion and creation of Registered Apprenticeships through the High Demand Career

Initiatives Program and

WHEREAS:

The Technical College System of Georgia is the largest network of Registered Apprenticeship Sponsors in the state, providing apprenticeship access to all

Georgians; and

WHEREAS:

Registered Apprenticeships are a key pillar to Georgia's Workforce Development Strategy, driving ongoing partnerships with the U. S. Department of Labor, Technical College System of Georgia, Georgia Department of Economic Development, Georgia Department of Labor, Georgia Department of Education, and our education and industry partners throughout the state; and

WHEREAS:

Registered Apprenticeships, a proven and industry-driven training model, are critical to creating talent pipelines to meet the workforce needs of our state, such as enhancing infrastructure, meeting critical supply chain demands, increasing access to healthcare, and ensuring the state continues to be the best place in the nation to live and do business; now

THEREFORE:

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 14-20, 2022, as APPRENTICESHIP WEEK in Georgia.
