## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **BLOOD DONATION DAY**

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia is committed to ensuring the safety and security of

all those living in and visiting our state; and

WHEREAS: A sufficient blood supply is important for public health, as our hospitals

and medical centers need a readily available supply for our residents and

visitors; and

WHEREAS: One blood donation can help save more than one life, and although most

of the U.S. population is eligible to donate blood, only around 3 percent

do; and

WHEREAS: Georgia is home to many public service organizations that are committed

to raising awareness about the importance of blood donation, including

the American Red Cross; and

WHEREAS: Georgia Blood Donation Day serves as an important reminder that we

need to constantly replenish our blood supply through donation and

community awareness; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby

proclaim September 4, 2022, as BLOOD DONATION DAY in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Two.
