## A PROCLAMATION CLEANING WEEK

**WHEREAS:** Cleaning and disinfection are an investment in protecting human health and safety; and

**WHEREAS:** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention stresses the importance of properly cleaning and disinfecting to protect against COVID-19 and other infectious diseases; and

**WHEREAS:** ISSA-The Worldwide Cleaning Industry Association found that routine cleaning and disinfection reduces the number of surfaces contaminated by viruses by 62 percent and thereby significantly reduces the rate of transmission of infectious diseases; and

**WHEREAS:** Manufacturers and distributors have worked 24/7 to produce and deliver critical cleaning and hygiene products throughout the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS:** Essential front-line cleaning professionals have worked tirelessly to combat the spread of COVID-19 since the onset of this pandemic; and

**WHEREAS:** The grateful citizens of the State of Georgia proudly support and join in this effort to bring attention to the importance of maintaining clean and sanitary conditions at work, in schools, and at home; now

**THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 27 – April 2, 2022, as CLEANING WEEK in Georgia.
