## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL** WEEK

WHEREAS: According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, intellectual and

> or developmental disabilities occur among all racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic groups. Recent estimates in the United States show that about one in six children are diagnosed to have one or more intellectual or developmental

disabilities; and

WHEREAS: Approximately 20,000 Georgians are employed as Direct Support Professionals,

> an essential job that requires a high level of skill, training, kindness, and dedication to promote opportunities for people with intellectual or developmental disabilities to fully participate as valued members of their

communities; and

WHEREAS: Direct Support Professionals must build close, respectful, and trusted

relationships with those for whom they work, requiring compassion, empathy,

and the highest ethical standards; and

WHEREAS: Direct Support Professionals must assist people to manage complex medical and

behavioral health needs, help people with communication, and provide intimate

personal support daily; and

WHEREAS: Georgia's Direct Support Professionals have historically provided for the health

and safety of our citizens with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia recognizes and honors this vital workforce with the hope

> of bringing awareness to the critical shortage of Direct Support Professionals and encourage interest in this rewarding profession which impacts the quality of

life for those with intellectual and or developmental disabilities; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

September 12-18 2022, as DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL WEEK in

Georgia.
