## **EHLERS-DANLOS SYNDROMES AND HYPERMOBILITY SPECTRUM DISORDERS AWARENESS MONTH**

WHEREAS:

Ehlers-Danlos Syndromes (EDS) represent multiple genetic disorders involving mutations in connective tissue that are characterized by joint hypermobility, skin

hyperextensibility, and tissue fragility; and

WHEREAS:

There are 13 types of EDS that are characterized by distinctive features, with

vascular Ehlers-Danlos being the most severe; and

WHEREAS:

While EDS has no known treatment or cure, early and accurate diagnosis can provide the opportunity to create life-saving medical plans and ensure quality of

life for those living with EDS; and

WHEREAS:

A network of EDS support groups can help connect those managing life with

the disease, as well as better inform the medical community and the general

public; and

WHEREAS:

Further awareness and medical research can bring hope for the development of

treatments and a cure for Ehlers-Danlos Syndromes; now

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2022 as EHLERS-DANLOS SYNDROMES AND HYPERMOBILITY
