## **A PROCLAMATION**

## FAIR HOUSING & EQUAL OPPORTUNITY MONTH

WHEREAS: The Georgia Fair Housing Law protects all individuals from discrimination in

any aspect relating to the sale, rental, or in the provision of brokerage services or brokerage facilities in connection therewith, because of an individual's race, color, religion, sex, disability or handicap, familial status, or national origin; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Fair Employment Practices Act safeguards all individuals in public

employment from discrimination in employment and promotes the elimination of discrimination against all public employees due to race, color, religion,

national origin, sex, disability, or age; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Commission on Equal Opportunity – the State of Georgia's Civil

Rights Department - has been vested with the authority and responsibility for

the enforcement of these civil rights statues; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia recognizes April as Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity

Month, providing an opportunity to highlight the importance of fair housing

nationwide; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

April 2022 as FAIR HOUSING & EQUAL OPPORTUNITY MONTH in

Georgia.
