## **APROCLAMATION**

## **GEORGIA PEANUT MONTH**

WHEREAS: Peanuts and peanut products are recognized throughout our nation and the

world as a highly appetizing and nutritious food, providing protein and other

nutrients as part of a well-balanced diet; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia ranks first in the nation in peanut production, producing

nearly 52 percent of the country's total peanut crop in 2021. Georgia also leads the country in peanut exports, making a substantial contribution to the

economic well-being of the United States; and

WHEREAS: Peanut production is the largest single cash food row crop in Georgia, with gross

farm receipts totaling hundreds of millions of dollars; and

WHEREAS: Hundreds of Georgia companies that are engaged in warehousing, processing,

manufacturing, and marketing entirely depend on the peanut industry, and the hundreds of other Georgia companies engaged in financing, supplies, distributing, and transporting all depend to some extent on the peanut industry;

and

WHEREAS: The Georgia peanut industry has played a significant role in the economic

growth and prosperity of our state, contributing an estimated \$2 billion to the state's economy, and supporting the livelihood of more than 150,000 Georgians;

and

WHEREAS: During Georgia Peanut Month, all Georgians are encouraged to enjoy delicious

Georgia peanuts raw, roasted, boiled, dipped in chocolate, or any number of ways generations have found to enjoy this deeply meaningful and important

crop; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

March 2022 as GEORGIA PEANUT MONTH in Georgia.
