WHEREAS: Lissencephaly is a rare gene-linked brain malformation, causing the brain to

have less or no ridges & folds; making it appear smooth. It is estimated about

1 in 100,000 individuals are born with this condition; and

WHEREAS: People living with this condition may also suffer from hypertonia, epilepsy,

swallowing disorders, developmental delays, and more; and

WHEREAS: Addressing these complex medical needs early in life is imperative to helping

families successfully care for their children at home. There is a great need for

more education, awareness, and support for families; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate that one day each year should be set apart from the rest and be

known as Lissencephaly Awareness Day, this day shall be on September 8th;

and

WHEREAS: Lissencephaly Foundation Inc; a nonprofit charitable organization, works to

help support these individuals by empowering families and educating

communities; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

September 8, 2022, as LISSENCEPHALY AWARENESS DAY in Georgia.
