WHEREAS: Mitral Valve Disease can result in fatal heart failure, not just affecting dogs but

also having a devastating emotional impact on their owners; and

WHEREAS: Many dogs with Mitral Valve Disease do not develop symptoms, or their

symptoms can be treated with medication, but for some dogs that develop

serious heart problems, life-saving surgery is the only option; and

WHEREAS: The necessary surgery requires skill and precision from the surgeon, and can be

prohibitively expensive for owners and too complex for many veterinary

surgeons; and

WHEREAS: One surgeon, Dr. Uechi from Japan, is proficient in performing the surgery, and

is attempting to come to the United States to train surgeons throughout the country in his techniques. By making the surgery more widely available, costs will decrease and more express will have the entire to save their decrease and
