management of cases, contribute substantially to the quality of legal services throughout the State of Georgia, and reduce legal costs to

the public; and

WHEREAS: Excellence, dedication, and integrity are the noteworthy

characteristics of paralegals, and those in Georgia uphold the highest

standards of professionalism; and

WHEREAS: The observance of Paralegal Week provides an opportunity for

Georgians to recognize paralegals throughout the state for their efforts to help our legal system perform at an important level of

efficiency; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby

proclaim June 5 – 11, 2022 as PARALEGAL WEEK in Georgia.
