United States and State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Purchasing has tremendous influence on the state's economy through the responsibility

of supply chain management and monitoring billions of dollars in goods and services to ensure competitive, fair, open, and transparent procurement processes and the best

value for every taxpayer dollar; and

WHEREAS: In addition to the procurement of commodities and services, purchasing professionals

add value to their organizations by negotiating and administering contracts; developing education, outreach, and training strategies; and cultivating relationships with suppliers and collaboration partners interested in the advancement of large and small businesses;

WHEREAS: Government purchasing professionals work diligently to meet unprecedented

challenges and in extreme, urgent conditions to secure materials and resources which contributes positively to safer and healthier communities throughout Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Over 600 state, local, and federal purchasing professionals make it possible for

government entities to accomplish their missions and serve the citizens of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: During the month of March, the Georgia Department of Administrative Services

(DOAS), Georgia Chapter of the National Institute of Governmental Purchasing (GANIGP), Governmental Procurement Association of Georgia, and the Coastal Georgia Chapter of NIGP, along with other professional procurement organizations in our state, participate in raising awareness of the importance of purchasing professions

in the fields of business, industry, and government; now
