A PROCLAMATION

REENTRY WEEK

WHEREAS: Reentry is the transition where individuals return back to their communities, in

pursuit of leading productive and contributive lives for themselves and their

families; and

WHEREAS: Reentry services professionals and practitioners are compassionate and devoted

public servants who serve those returning to society with resources and support

to overcome barriers and stigma; and

WHEREAS: Reentry, when fully implemented, empowers returning citizens to refrain from

crime and incentivizes law-abiding behavior, thus supporting public safety in

our local communities and across the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: The process of preparing people for release includes addressing a wide range of

needs and involves providers in the areas of housing, medical, job readiness,

financial literacy, faith-based services, and more; and

WHEREAS: Georgia is fortunate to have the Department of Community Supervision and a

network of several other agencies and organizations, like Returning Citizens, align their work to provide a seamless plan of services to every individual

returning to their respective communities; and

WHEREAS: Reentry services professionals are a true force for positive change and work

diligently to advocate and restore justice to impacted communities, advancing the vision that every person who is released from incarceration will have the

resources and support needed to succeed; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

April 24 – 30, 2022 as REENTRY WEEK in Georgia.
