## STEWARDSHIP WEEK

WHEREAS: Soil, water, and other natural resources are crucial parts of life, and wise use

and stewardship of these resources is essential to maintain healthy and thriving

populations of plants, animals, and people alike; and

WHEREAS: Stewardship Week is one of the largest conservation events that recognizes

Conservation Districts, the work they do, and natural resource stewardship as a

whole; and

WHEREAS: Conservation Districts were formed across the country in the 1930's in the

aftermath of the Dust Bowl to ensure continued protection of natural resources through local leadership; Georgia is home to 40 of these invaluable districts; and

WHEREAS: In recognition of Stewardship Week, Conservation Districts across the state will

be engaging in outreach and programs that educate and empower people to get

involved and change their communities and the world; and

WHEREAS: All Georgians are encouraged to recognize the importance of natural resource

stewardship in the Peach State through observing Stewardship Week; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

April 24 – May 1, 2022, as STEWARDSHIP WEEK in Georgia.
