VIDEO GAMES DAY

WHEREAS: Video Games Day is a day to celebrate the joy that video games bring to the

lives of so many, providing an opportunity for gamers of all ages, races, and

creeds to come together and share their love for video games; and

WHEREAS: Video Games Day brings awareness and celebrates the history and fun of video

games. Video Games are now a huge industry and have led into competitive

gaming known as Esports; and

WHEREAS: Gerald "Jerry" Lawson, the father of modern gaming, developed the Fairchild

Channel F in 1976, which allowed users to insert different cartridges that allowed people to play a variety of games in their homes on a single console. This paved the way for much more elaborate systems users know and love today;

WHEREAS: Organizations such as Pharaoh's Conclave, in partnership with Morris Brown

College, are using video games to open doors through actions such as establishing the Ronald Floyd Thomas Center for Esports & Innovation to build awareness, educate, and promote STEAM-based education, thereby creating

access and opportunity for underserved communities; and
