WHEREAS: Aquatic-related activities such as swimming relate to good physical

and mental health and enhance the quality of life for all people; and

WHEREAS: Education regarding the topic of water safety plays an essential role

in preventing drownings and recreational water-related injuries; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia recreational water industry, as represented by the

organizations involved in the National Water Safety Month Coalition, develops safe swimming facilities, aquatic programs, home pools and spas, and related activities providing healthy places to recreate, learn, and grow, and build self-esteem, confidence, and a sense of self-worth, which contribute to the quality of life in our

community; and

WHEREAS: It is important to recognize the ongoing efforts and commitments

to educate the public on pool and spa safety issues and initiatives by

the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation, and parks industries; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia understands the vital importance of

communicating Water Safety rules and programs to families and individuals of all ages, whether owners of private pools, users of

public swimming facilities, or visitors to waterparks; now

**THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby

proclaim May 2022 as WATER SAFETY MONTH in Georgia.
