

House Bill 1408 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Shellman, approved April 19, 2000  
2 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 4412), as amended, so as to revise provisions related to selection of the  
3 mayor pro tempore; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other  
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Shellman, approved April 19, 2000 (Ga.  
8 L. 2000, p. 4412), as amended, is amended by revising Section 2.31 as follows:

9 "SECTION 2.31.

10 Mayor pro tempore; selection; duties.

11 The city councilmember who receives the greatest number of votes in the municipal  
12 general election held immediately preceding the organizational meeting of the city council  
13 provided for in Section 2.18 of this charter shall serve as mayor pro tempore. In the  
14 mayor's absence, the mayor pro tempore shall preside at meetings of the city council and

15 shall assume the duties and powers of the mayor upon the mayor's physical or mental  
16 disability; provided, however, that the mayor pro tempore shall vote as a member of the  
17 city council at all times when serving as provided for in this section."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
