## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to revise, modernize, and consolidate the provisions of local law relating 2 to the State Court of Putnam County (formerly the County Court of Putnam County), approved April 4, 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 3839), as amended, so as to provide that on and after 3 4 January 1, 2023, the district attorney of the judicial circuit within which Putnam County is 5 located shall represent the state in all criminal prosecutions brought in the State Court of Putnam County and shall perform the duties of the office of solicitor-general of the state 6 7 court; to provide for the powers, duties, and responsibilities of said district attorney in such 8 state court; to authorize the establishment of a state court division by said district attorney; 9 to provide for the assignment, appointment, and compensation of personnel by said district 10 attorney; to provide for annual budgeting; to provide for the transfer of books, papers, and 11 other office property to said district attorney; to provide that no election shall be held for the 12 office of solicitor-general of the state court; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

In addition, the district attorney shall be 34 authorized to appoint at least one administrative, clerical, and paraprofessional personnel 35 to provide support for the state court division. 39 No election shall be held for the office of solicitor-general of the State Court of Putnam 40 County for the term of office that begins on or after January 1, 2023, and such office shall stand abolished. On or after January 1, 2023, any reference in this Act or any other law of 41 42 this state to the solicitor-general of the State Court of Putnam County shall be deemed to mean and refer to the district attorney of the judicial circuit in which Putnam County is 43 44 located. It shall be the duty of the solicitor-general of the State Court of Putnam County 45 to deliver all books, papers, and other office property to the district attorney of such circuit as provided by Code Section 45-6-7 of the O.C.G.A. on or before the end of the term of 46 47 office to which said solicitor-general was elected or vacating said office, whichever occurs first." 48
