A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act establishing a civil service system for the employees of Clayton County,
2 approved March 29, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 4399), as amended, so as to exclude additional
3 employee positions from such civil service system; to provide for related matters; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act establishing a civil service system for the employees of Clayton County, approved
8 March 29, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 4399), as amended, is amended by striking in its entirety
9 subsection (c) of Section 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10 "(c) All employees of Clayton County may be placed under the civil service system except
11 elected officials, appointed boards, members of commissions and authorities, probationary
12 employees, temporary employees, part-time employees, judges of the juvenile court, judges
13 of the magistrate court, the chief administrator, the chief operating officer, the economic
14 development officer, the staff attorney, deputy clerks of the superior and state courts,
15 deputy tax commissioners, investigators and attorneys within the office of the

16 solicitor-general, court reporters, law clerks, department directors, department heads, and
17 other employees expressly exempt by law."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
