A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 vocational, technical, and adult education, so as to provide for the State Board of the 3 Technical College System of Georgia to establish a program to promote the creation and 4 expansion of registered apprenticeship programs in the state; to provide the purpose of such 5 program; to authorize the board to enter into contracts with employer sponsors for the 6 successful completion of the education, training, and other requirements of apprentices in 7 Georgia; to provide application requirements and procedures; to authorize contract 8 completion awards; to require the board to create and publish a list of high-demand jobs in 9 Georgia; to require a report; to authorize the acceptance of grants and other funds; to provide 10 for definitions; to provide for rules and regulations; to provide for a repealer; to provide for 11 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

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- 14 Chapter 4 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to vocational,
- 15 technical, and adult education, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

16 "ARTICLE 7

- 17 <u>20-4-150.</u>
- 18 As used in this article, the term:
- 19 (1) 'Apprentice' means a person who is at least 15 years of age, except where a higher
- 20 <u>minimum age is required by law, who is employed in an eligible apprenticeable</u>
- 21 <u>occupation, and is registered in Georgia with the United States Department of Labor</u>
- 22 Office of Apprenticeship.
- 23 (2) 'Apprenticeable occupation' means an occupation approved for apprenticeship by the
- 24 <u>United States Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship.</u>
- 25 (3) 'Apprenticeship program' means a program registered with the United States
- 26 Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship that includes terms and conditions for the
- 27 qualification, recruitment, selection, employment, and training of apprentices, including
- 28 <u>the requirement for a written apprenticeship agreement.</u>
- 29 (4) 'Apprenticeship sponsor' means:
- 30 (A) Any entity operating an apprenticeship program; or
- 31 (B) Any entity in whose name an apprenticeship program is being operated that is
- 32 <u>registered with or approved by the United States Department of Labor Office of</u>
- 33 <u>Apprenticeship.</u>
- 34 (5) 'Board' means the State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia.
- 35 (6) 'Eligible apprenticeable occupation' means an apprenticeable occupation identified
- 36 by the Office of Workforce Development pursuant to Code Section 20-4-152 as a
- 37 <u>high-demand job.</u>
- 38 (7) 'Employer sponsor' means an employer that coordinates with or is an apprenticeship
- 39 sponsor and employs and trains an apprentice.
- 40 (8) 'Office of Workforce Development' means the Technical College System of Georgia's
- 41 <u>Office of Workforce Development.</u>

- 42 <u>20-4-151.</u>
- 43 (a) Subject to appropriations of funds by the General Assembly for this purpose, the board,
- 44 in coordination with the Department of Labor, the Department of Economic Development,
- 45 the Department of Education, and the Office of Planning and Budget, shall establish and
- 46 administer a program through the Office of Workforce Development to be called the
- 47 <u>High-demand Career Initiatives Program.</u> The purpose of the program is to incentivize
- 48 apprenticeship sponsors to establish new or grow existing registered apprenticeship
- 49 programs in Georgia in order to support the growth of apprenticeship programs and expand
- 50 <u>high-quality work-based learning experiences in high-demand fields and careers for</u>
- 51 persons in Georgia.
- 52 (b) An employer sponsor may apply to the board for the opportunity to enter into a
- 53 contract to perform the requirements of conducting an apprenticeship program for a
- 54 specific apprentice. Such contract shall require the employer sponsor's apprentice to
- 55 <u>successfully complete an apprenticeship program.</u>
- 56 (c) The board shall provide upon request and on the Technical College System of
- 57 Georgia's website information about the program, the application, application instructions,
- 58 and the application period established each year for contracts for services available under
- 59 the program.
- 60 (d) Upon successful completion of the requirements of a contract under this article, the
- board shall provide a contract completion award to the employer sponsor. The contract
- 62 completion award amount shall be determined based on the number of hours of education
- and training required for the successful completion of the apprenticeship under such
- apprenticeship program but shall not exceed \$10,000.00 per apprentice.
- 65 (e) Each employer sponsor shall only be eligible to enter into contracts under this article
- 66 for up to five apprentices per year.
- 67 (f) An apprenticeship sponsor may assist with the application for and completion of an
- apprenticeship contract authorized by this article.

- 70 (a) The board, in coordination with the Office of Workforce Development, shall create
- 71 <u>annually and publish on its website a list of high-demand jobs state wide for purposes of</u>
- 72 <u>the High-demand Career Initiatives Program.</u>
- 73 (b) The Office of Workforce Development shall publish and maintain criteria for the
- 74 <u>selection of high-demand jobs eligible for the High-demand Career Initiatives Program.</u>
- 75 20-4-153.
- 76 (a) The Office of Workforce Development shall annually report on its website the
- 77 <u>following information:</u>
- 78 (1) The total amount of compensation awarded under this article;
- 79 (2) The amount of compensation awarded in each field of high-demand jobs;
- 80 (3) The total number of contracts entered into and the number of contracts completed;
- 81 (4) The total number of contracts entered per eligible occupation and the number of those
- 82 <u>completed</u>;
- 83 (5) The total amount awarded overall with respect to each eligible occupation;
- 84 (6) The total number of apprentices who attended an institution of the Technical College
- 85 System of Georgia during the course of his or her apprenticeship program; and
- 86 (7) The total number of apprentices who did not attend an institution of the Technical
- 87 <u>College System of Georgia during the course of his or her apprenticeship program.</u>
- 88 (b) Each apprenticeship sponsor shall fully cooperate in providing statistical information
- 89 requested by the board or, at the board's discretion, be excluded from participating in the
- 90 <u>High-demand Career Initiatives Program.</u>
- 91 20-4-154.
- 92 The board shall adopt rules and regulations establishing a staff review and application
- 93 approval process, application scoring criteria, the minimum score necessary for approval

of a contract, the terms of agreement between an employer sponsor and the board, and any

- 95 other rules deemed necessary for the implementation and administration of this article.
- 96 20-4-155.
- 97 To assist in carrying out this article, the State Board of the Technical College System of
- 98 Georgia is authorized to accept grants of money, materials, services, or property of any
- 99 kind from a federal agency, private agency, corporation, or individual.
- 100 <u>20-4-156.</u>
- 101 This article shall stand repealed on July 1, 2027."
- SECTION 2.
- 103 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
