**AS PASSED**

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act reconstituting the Board of Education of Warren County, approved  
2 February 4, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 3651), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
3 May 8, 2017 (Ga. L. 2017, p. 3990), so as to revise the compensation provisions for the  
4 chairperson and for members of the board; to provide for related matters; to provide an  
5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act reconstituting the Board of Education of Warren County, approved February 4, 1993  
9 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 3651), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 8, 2017  
10 (Ga. L. 2017, p. 3990), is amended by revising Section 6 as follows:

11 "SECTION 6.

12 (a) The chairperson of the Board of Education shall receive \$250.00 per meeting as  
13 compensation for his or her service.

14 (b) The members of the Board of Education other than the chairperson shall  
15 receive \$200.00 per meeting as compensation for their service.

16 (c) The chairperson and board members shall not receive compensation pursuant to  
17 subsection (a) or (b) of this section for more than one meeting per day unless meetings  
18 occur more than two hours apart.

19 (d) In addition to the compensation provided for in subsection (a) or (b) of this section,  
20 when traveling on official business for the board or school district, the chairperson and  
21 board members shall receive the same per diem travel allowance as that received by  
22 employees of the Warren County school district."

23 **SECTION 2.**

24 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which  
25 such Act is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

26 **SECTION 3.**

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
