EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR TORNADOES AND SEVERE STORMS

**PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 38-3-51, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN
ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

ORDERED:

That the State of Emergency for Tornadoes and Severe Storms declared on January 12, 2023, by Executive Order No. 01.12.23.02, which is set to expire on January 19, 2023, at 11:59 P.M., is hereby extended for seven (7) days and shall expire on Thursday, January 26, 2023, at 11:59 P.M., unless it is otherwise renewed by the Governor.
