EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 8.98 acres of improved real property

(hereinafter the "Property") in 8th G.M. District, Plat of Lot 2C, Dogwood Tract, Chatham County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of a Quitclaim Deed dated June 23, 2009, recorded in Deed Book 354Q, pages 720-724, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Chatham County, and filed with the State Properties

Commission Real Property Record as RPR# 10652; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Agriculture and is commonly

known as the Savannah Farmers Market; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with structures identified as "Buildings 3 and 4" (BLLIP

ID # 8233) and totaling 26,362 square feet (hereinafter, collectively, the

"Structure") as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS: Said Structure's trusses have failed and exceeded their serviceable life making the

Structure beyond reasonable repair; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated March 31, 2023, the Commissioner of the Department of Agriculture

requested authority to demolish the Structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Department of Agriculture is authorized and directed to provide for the razing,

demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are

deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
