EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN CRISP COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

- WHEREAS:** Deputy Tyee Browne with the Crisp County Sheriff's Office was killed in the line of duty on Wednesday, July 5, 2023, while conducting a traffic stop; and
- WHEREAS:** Deputy Browne graduated from the police academy in September 2022 and had served with the Crisp County Sheriff's Office since his graduation; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Deputy Browne's service to Crisp County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Crisp County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF DEPUTY TYEE BROWNE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Crisp County on Monday, July 10, 2023, the day of Deputy Browne's interment, until sunset.
