EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 6,385 acres of improved real

property (hereinafter the "Property") in the 1645th GMD, Tattnall County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of various deeds and filed in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Tattnall County, and filed with the State Properties Commission Real

Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 51098; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Corrections and is commonly

known as Rogers State Prison; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with a structure identified as "House 163" (BLLIP ID #

8233) and totaling 1,700 square feet (hereinafter, collectively, the "Structure") as

shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS: Said Structure had a fire on January 9, 2022, and the Structure was a total loss. The

cost to repair the Structure far exceeded its serviceable life making the Structure

beyond reasonable repair; and

WHEREAS: By resolution dated June 1, 2023, the Board of the Department of Corrections

requested authority to demolish the Structure.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: The Department of Corrections is authorized and directed to provide for the razing,

demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are

deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
