## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, SANFORD STADIUM, IN ATHENS-CLARKE COUNTY, AND IN CHATHAM COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Mr. Frank W. "Sonny" Seiler, famed Savannah attorney, DGD, and legendary

figure of the University of Georgia passed away on Monday, August 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Seiler served as patriarch of college sports' most famous mascot - the

University of Georgia's English Bulldog – since his first bulldog, Hood's Ole Dan,

took the field at the 1956 home opener against Florida State as Uga I; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Seiler demonstrated his nearest duty by dedicating his Uga line as the

University of Georgia mascots from 1956 to present day as Ugas I-XI, establishing

a tradition of unbridled excellence; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Seiler was a "Double Dawg" graduate of the University of Georgia; he was

awarded the Distinguished American Award by the UGA Chapter of the National Football Foundation and received the UGA Alumni Association's National Alumni Merit Award, demonstrating a life-long commitment to the idea that there is no tradition more worthy of envy, no institution worthy of such loyalty as the

University of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Seiler honorably served as First Lieutenant in the United States Army and as

an officer in the Georgia National Guard, 230th Field Artillery; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Mr. Seiler's life by lowering flags to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as mark of respect for the memory of Mr. Frank W. "Sonny" Seiler, pursuant to the authority vested

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at

half-staff at the State Capitol, Sanford Stadium, in Athens-Clarke County, and in
