EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On August 14, 2023, Mr. Shawn Still, Senator of Senate District 48 in the Georgia

State Senate, was indicted on one felony count of Violation of the Georgia Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act, one felony count of Impersonating a Public Officer, two felony counts of Forgery in the First Degree, two felony counts of False Statement and Writings, and one felony count of

Criminal Attempt to Commit Filing False Documents; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of such indictment was transmitted to the Governor on August 16,

2023; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to GA. CONST. Art. II, § III, ¶ I, no sooner than 14 days after receipt of a

certified copy of a felony indictment of a member of the General Assembly, the Governor shall appoint a review commission composed of the Attorney General, one member of the Georgia State Senate, and one member of the Georgia House of

Representatives; and

WHEREAS: The review commission shall determine if the indictment relates to and adversely

affects the administration of the member's office and whether the rights and

interests of the public are adversely affected thereby.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Ga. Const. Art. II, § III, ¶ I and the

AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA IT IS

HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Senator Steve Gooch of Senate District 51 in the Georgia State Senate, and Representative Chuck Efstration of House District

on the Georgia State Senate, and Representative Chuck Efstration of House District to 4 in the Georgia House of Representatives are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine if the indictment of Senator Shawn Still relates to and adversely affects the administration of his office and that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me of

such determination within 14 days.
